TOUR SERVICES

La Fonda is considered to be in the center of the "hundred most fascinating square miles in America". If you would like to learn more, speak to our Concierge or consider one of these recommended Tour/Travel Partners:

LORETTO LINE - TROLLEY/TRAM TOURS

The city tour covers an 8 mile loop in downtown, which includes the most important historical areas: up Canyon Road, through residential neighborhoods, pointing out museums and highlights of Santa Fe. Fully narrated. Tours last approx 1¼ hours.

Service runs from mid-April to the end of October. Departures: 10:30am, 12:30pm & 2:30pm in front of the La Fonda.

HISTORIC WALKS OF SANTA FE - (505) 986-8388

HISTORIC/CULTURAL TOUR: Led by museum docent guides, this tour is a leisurely stroll throughout the city's historic downtown district, covering such sites as St. Francis Cathedral and Loretto Chapel. \$14 per person. Departs daily from La Fonda lobby daily at 9:45am and 1:15pm. Wear comfortable shoes.

GHOSTWALKERS TOUR: Led by guide/re-enactor Allan "Tex" Wheeler portraying Captain William Becknell, Father of the Santa Fe Trail in full western attire, this tour is a true adventure into the past! \$14 per person. Departs from La Fonda lobby at 6:00pm Tuesdays, Fridays & Saturdays. Reservation required!

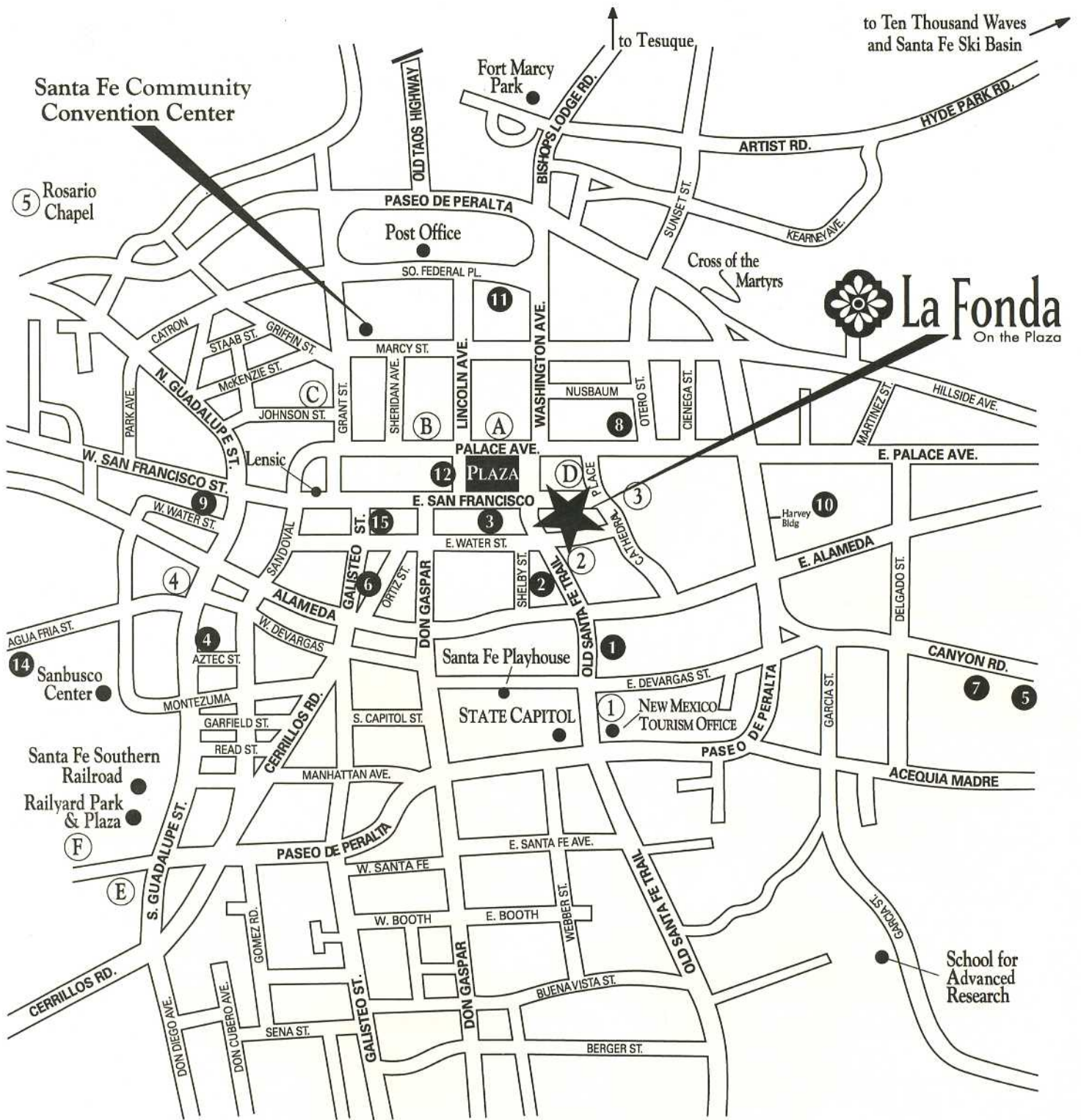

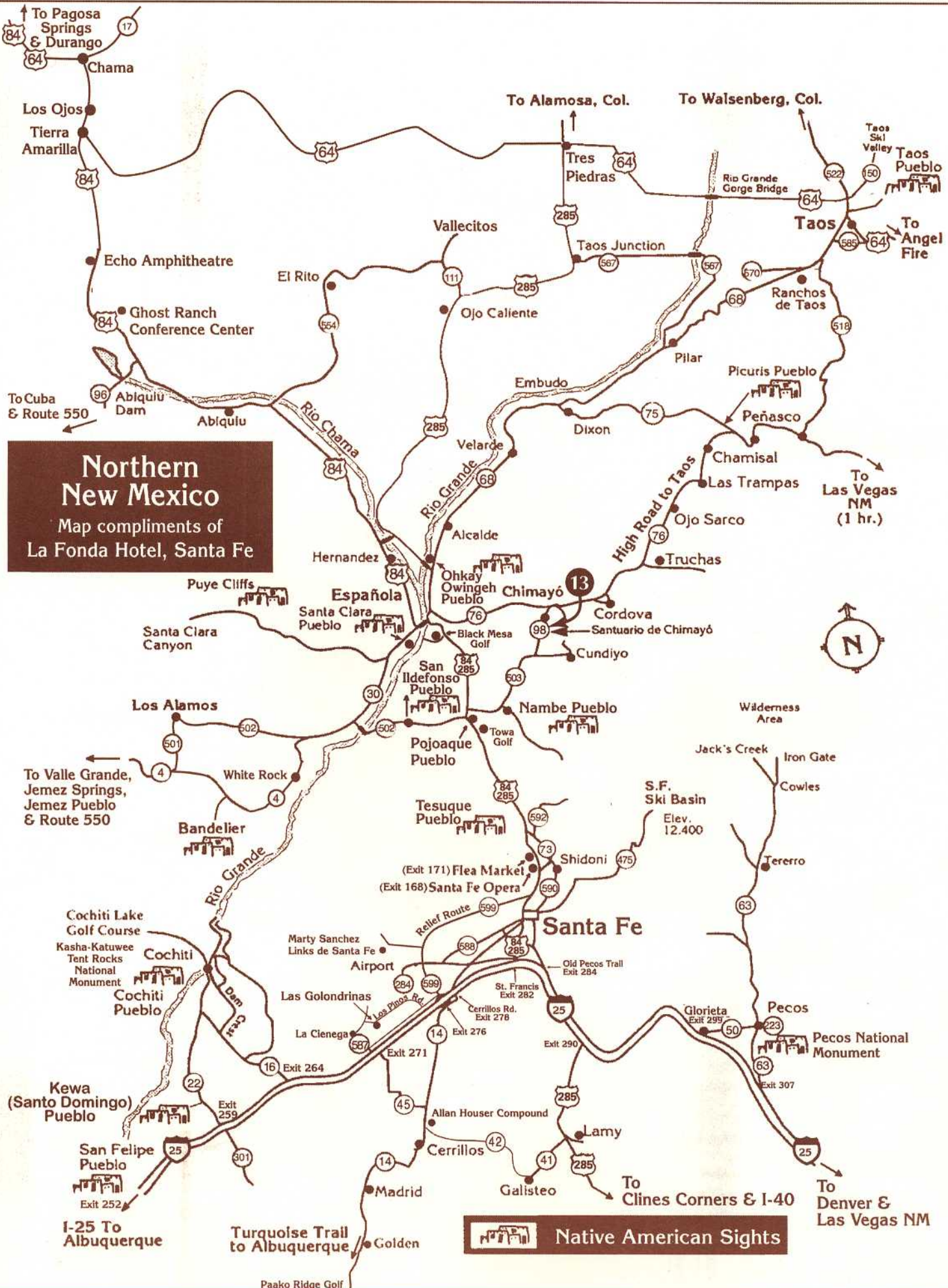
